Prerequisites:

- 1. Be a REGREEN Trained Certificate of Completion holder*
- 2. Be employed by a USGBC National Member company*
 - * No exceptions to these requirements.

Other Qualifications:

- 5 years of sustainable project experience as a residential contractor/building science practitioner or residential interior designer
- Practical application of REGREEN Guidelines and principles on projects (3-5 projects preferred)
- Demonstrated commitment to the REGREEN program
- Demonstrate excellence in teaching, training, presentation and/or facilitation skills

What is the REGREEN 301: Implementing Residential Remodeling Program?

This 2-day 300 level workshop was designed to assist residential remodeling professionals in implementing a whole-house systems approach on their retrofit projects. Building on the foundational knowledge of the REGREEN Residential Remodeling Guidelines and online courses, the workshop assists the professional in identifying and evaluating which green considerations, concepts and strategies will make a meaningful and positive impact in their next project. The workshop discusses the science behind green remodeling strategies and how to implement them while capitalizing on positive synergies and avoiding unintended negative ones.

This workshop is a required component in the REGREEN Trained Certificate of Completion, which offers professionals a way to differentiate themselves in the marketplace. This highly integrated and dynamic workshop calls for two REGREEN Faculty members: One leader in the field of building science and residential construction and another leader in the field of residential interior design.

Faculty are required to sign an annual contract. The 2011 administrative fee is \$500. The contract allows Faculty to instruct USGBC workshop curriculum world-wide, and our international programs are rapidly expanding!
