Personal Narrative:

As a principal with WBRC Architect-Engineers in Maine from 2000-2008 he served as the environmental consultant for the first LEED building at the University of Maine, designed a building for the Mount Desert Island Biological Laboratory that is pursuing LEED Gold, designed the Presque Isle Middle School, the first High Performance School in Maine, consulted on sustainable master plans for the College of the Atlantic and Maine Maritime Academy and facilitated eco-charrettes across the country. Currently, Richard is a project architect with the Minneapolis office of Perkins+Will.

As a volunteer with the US Green Building Council, Richard founded the Maine Chapter and served as its first chair. Under his leadership the group advocated for the second Executive Order requiring LEED for State buildings in Maine, collaborated on the first green affordable housing standard in the country with Maine State Housing, and certified the first LEED-Home in the country in Freeport. Nationally for the US Green Building Council Richard has served on the Integrated Business Plan Task Force, Upper Northeast Regional Council, Chapter Steering Committee, and the National Board and is currently serving on the Executive Committee as the Board Secretary.
