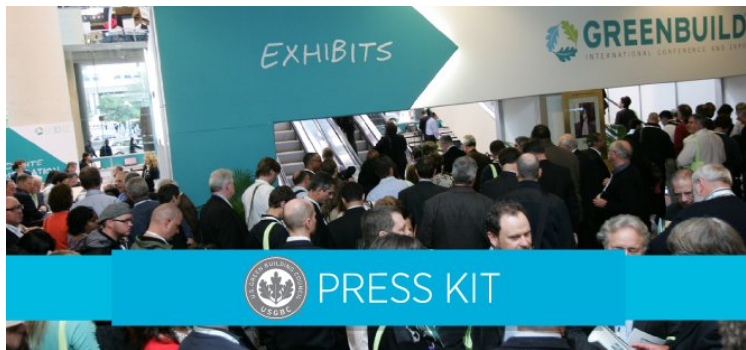

About: USGBC's [Greenbuild International Conference & Expo](#) is the world's largest conference dedicated to green building. Greenbuild is the ideal space to learn about the newest, most groundbreaking green building products, services and technologies. Over 17,500 attendees convened in New Orleans, LA in 2014 for three days of education sessions, renowned speakers, green building tours and networking. There were also 552 exhibiting companies participating in 142,000 square feet of exhibit and display space on the trade show floor in New Orleans. There were over 240 sessions, tours, summits and workshops over the course of the week, and an impressive 37,250 hours of continuing education credits were earned at Greenbuild 2014.

- Philanthropist and climate change advocate Tom Steyer co-hosted an entertaining opening plenary discussion in the New Orleans's Superdome along with Maryland Governor Martin O'Malley and moderator Paul Hawken.

- All exhibiting companies participate in the Greenbuild Mandatory Exhibition Green Guidelines, which enforce green practices for booth construction, reuse, material selection and operations.
- To encourage attendees to walk to and from the conference, Greenbuild offers a shoe check-in.
