What determines whether a remodeling project is a "Major Renovation" vs. an "Operations & Maintenance" repair project? I am involved with a roof repair project for an 8,000 sf office bldg with a leaky roof that may involve: replacement of the entire roof; conversion of 75% of the roof to an ecoroof system; a new Mechanical & HVAC system; replacement of all windows; and some reconfiguration of the interior partition walls; all aimed at LEED Silver certification. The building footprint and exterior walls will remain the same, aside from the new low-energy windows.
