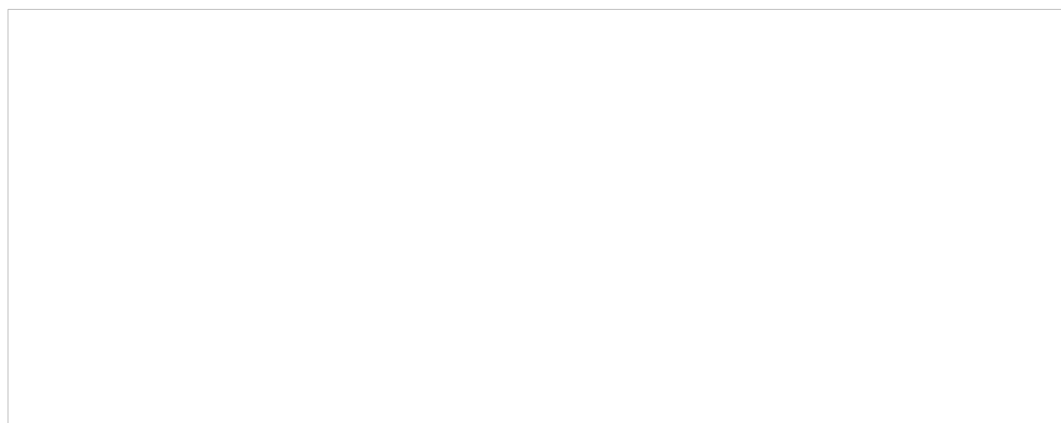

- The [Greenbuild sustainability program](#) addresses environmental impact through seven objectives: move toward a zero waste event; increase stakeholder education and engagement; improve sustainable sourcing; improve performance tracking; reduce greenhouse gas emissions; positively impact communities; and Catalyze the advancement of green building initiatives and sustainable initiatives within the hospitality industry.

Greenbuild international conferences

- **In 2015, USGBC partnered with [Green Building Council Italia](#), [Veronafi](#) and Informa to bring Greenbuild to Europe and the Mediterranean. [Greenbuild EuroMed](#) was held in Verona, Italy Oct. 14-16, 2015 and featured more than 32 education sessions, LEED workshops, summits, expo education sessions and tours of notable areas in Verona.**
- **The 2016 [Greenbuilding Brazil](#), now in its seventh year, was co-hosted with the [High Design Expo](#), a show focused on the home and office.** The partnership between these two shows has created a stronger and more comprehensive meeting for Architecture, Construction and Design, with an estimated 15,000 professionals in attendance and 20,000 square meters of space featuring over 200 companies. Greenbuilding Brazil was held in São Paulo, Brazil Aug. 9-11, 2016.
