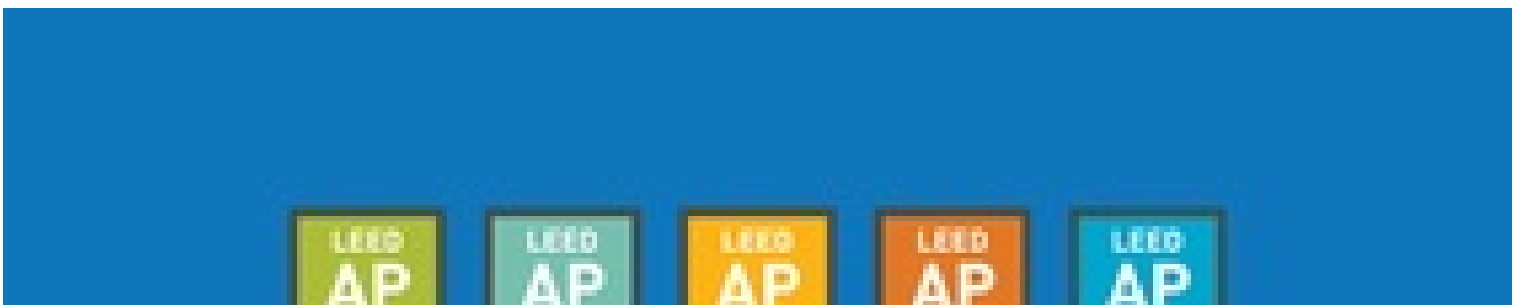
The following committees are seeking new members:

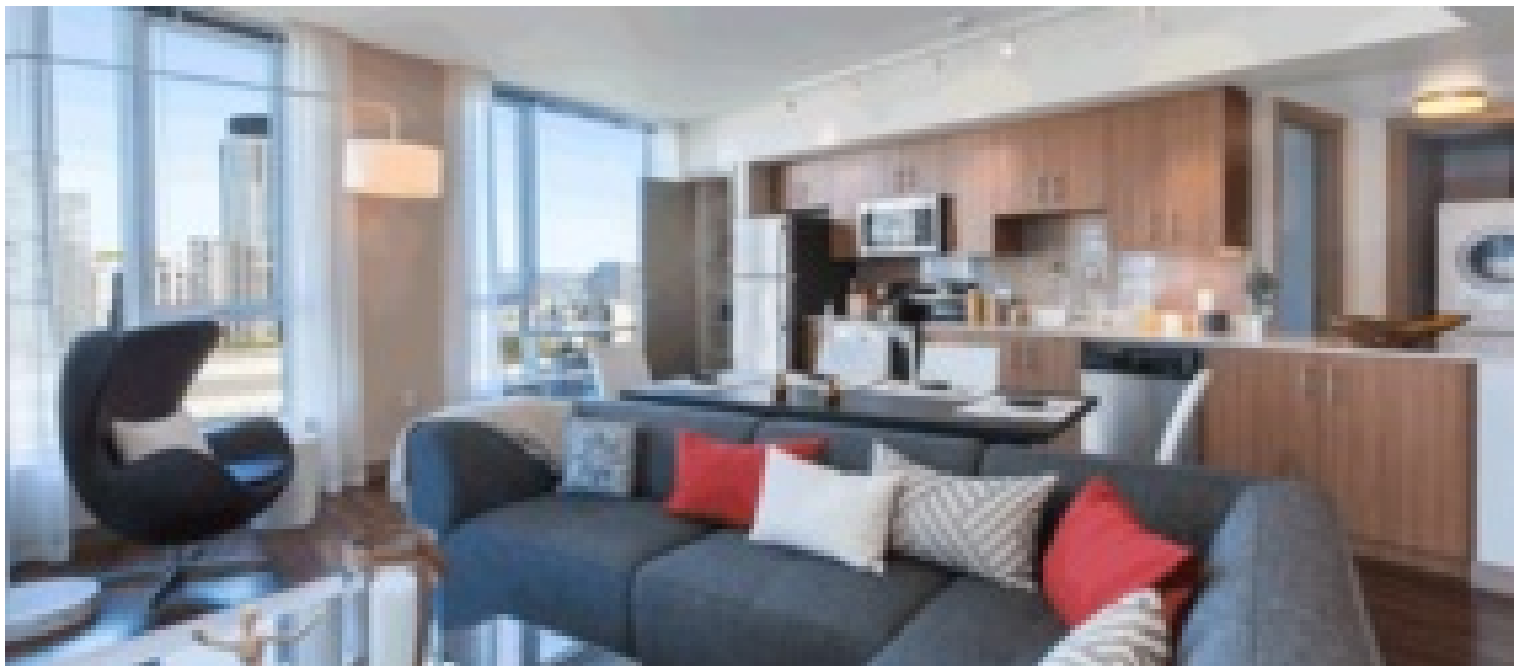
