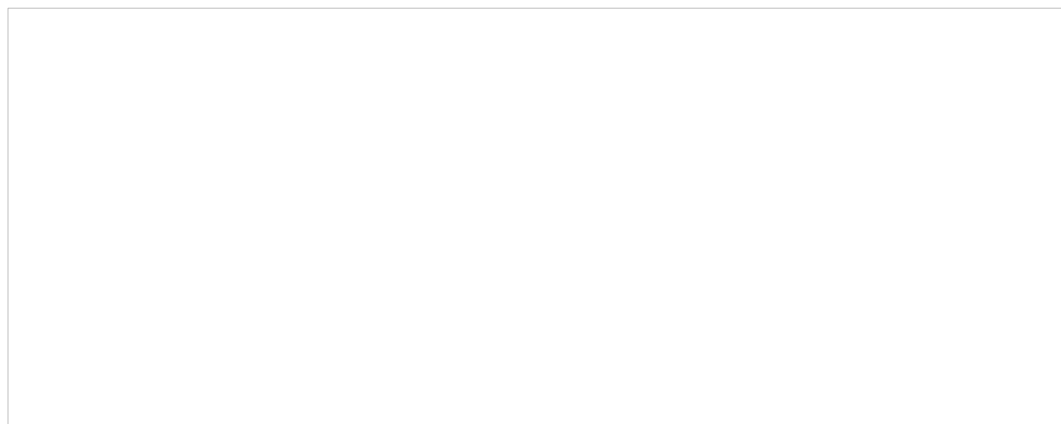

- Ten years of professional green building experience

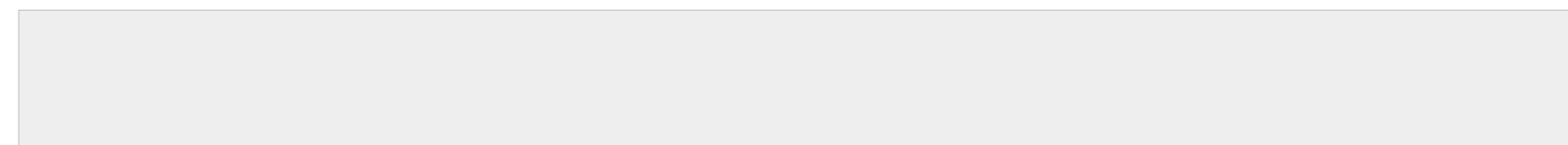
