As we continue leveraging the [cultural influence of sports](#) to advance green building, we're taking to social media to engage players and fans alike.

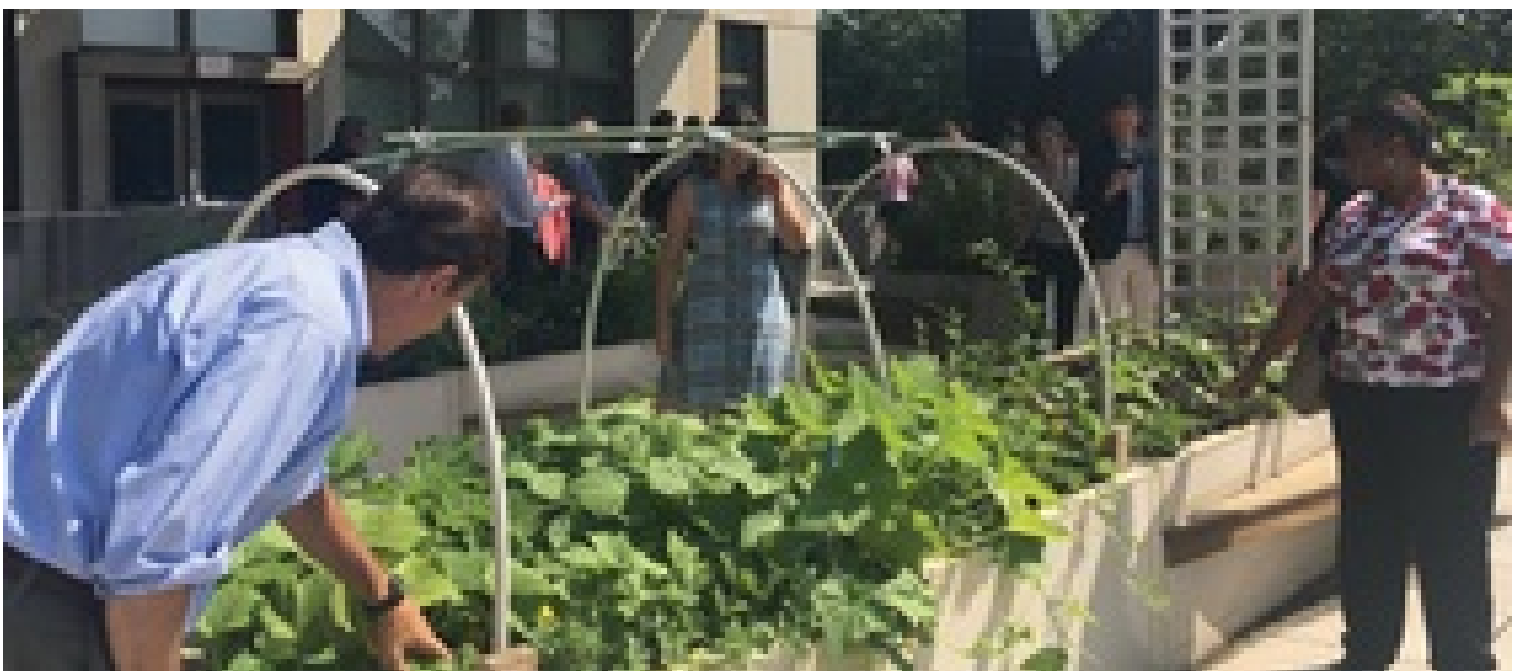

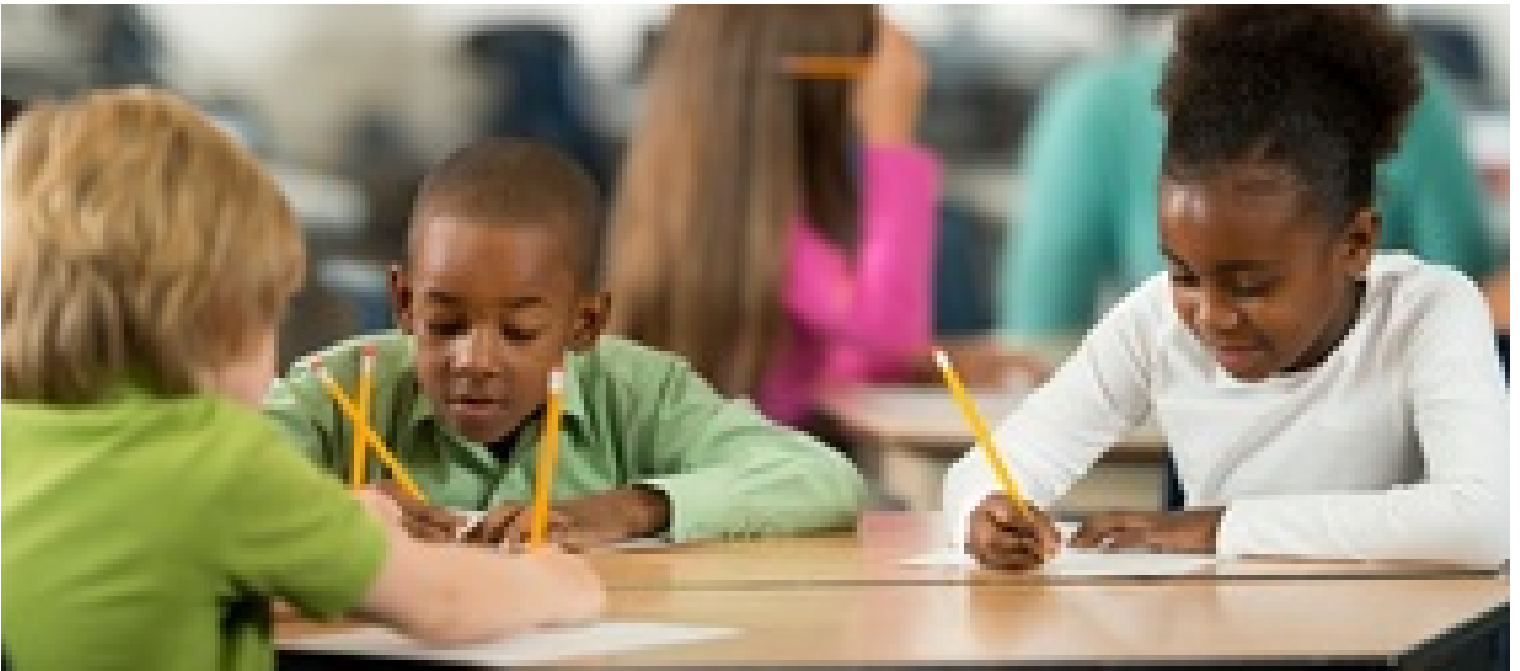
